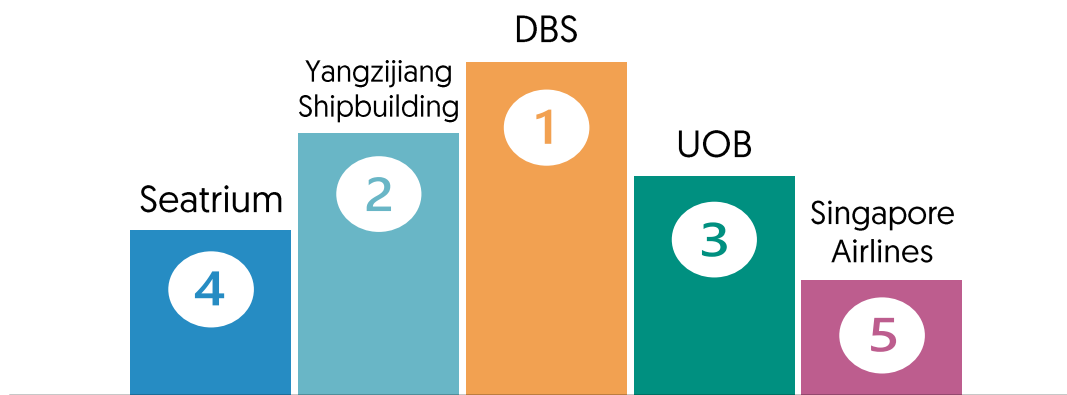

1 DBS

- DBS set to cut 4,000 temporary jobs over 3 years due to Artificial Intelligence (24 Feb 2025, Reuters)
- DBS likely a safe haven amid market volatility (11 Feb 2025, Dow Jones Newswires)
- DBS delivered another year of record profit, raised its ordinary dividend and announced an additional capital return for 2025 (10 Feb 2025, Dow Jones Newswires)



2 Yangzijiang Shipbuilding

- Yangzijiang Shipbuilding's shares dropped on 27 Feb 2025, after the company warned that proposed US fees on Chinese ships could affect new orders in the near term (27 Feb 2025, Dow Jones Newswires)
- Yangzijiang Shipbuilding's attributable profit to equity holders jumped 51% in the second half of 2024 to 3.58 billion yuan from 2.38 billion yuan a year earlier (27 Feb 2025, MT Newswires)



3 UOB

- UOB, through its Sydney branch, filed for the listing of AU\$2.0 billion worth of senior unsecured floating rate bonds due 2028 on the Singapore bourse (28 Feb 2025, MT Newswires)
- UOB's sale of its Chinese retail banking division will not significantly alter its financial standing. The move enables the Singapore-based banking group to concentrate on its corporate banking business in China and leverage growth opportunities across Asia (28 Feb 2025, Dow Jones Newswires)



4 Seatrium

- Seatrium's profit recovery looks sustainable, noting the company's first full year of profits since 2017 in 2024 (26 Feb 2025, Dow Jones Newswires)
- Seatrium's order book faces upside risks from President Trump's focus on US energy dominance. Trump has laid out a plan to unleash US oil and gas production and boost output, which includes promoting oil and gas development in Alaska (18 Feb 2025, Dow Jones Newswires)



5 Singapore Airlines

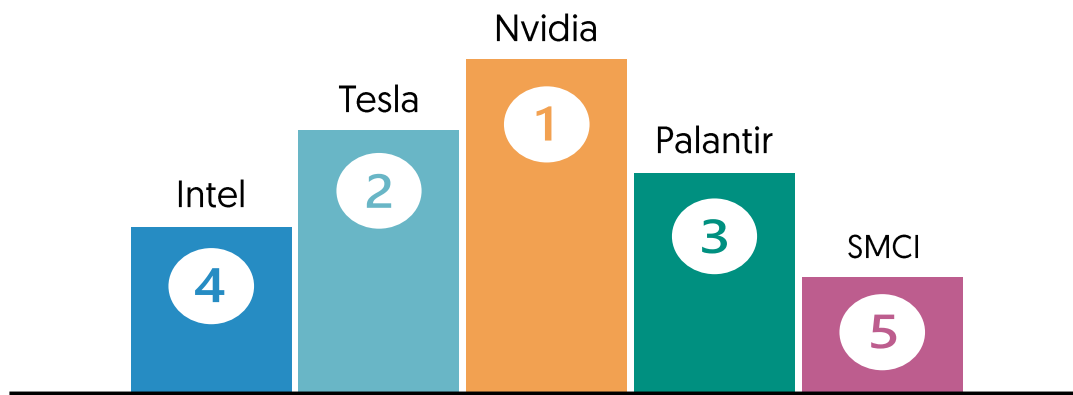
- Singapore Airlines is likely to enjoy continued healthy passenger and cargo demand. SIA posted improved operating results in 3Q FY 2025 such as passenger-flown revenue growing 1.7% on year on the back of a record 10.2 million passengers flown (24 Feb 2025, Dow Jones Newswires)
- Singapore Airlines said passenger traffic rose 9.1% year on year in January, driven by Lunar New Year travel, with 3.5 million passengers carried across its network (18 Feb 2025, MT Newswires)

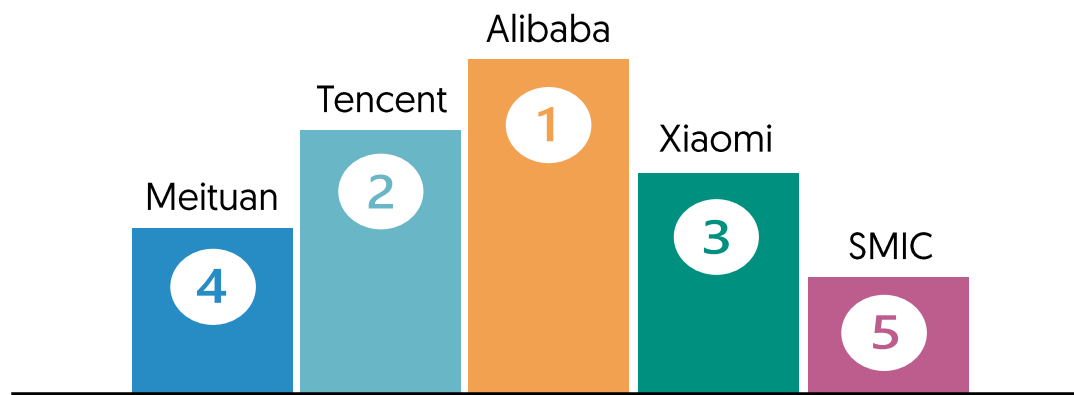
